Our Different Programmes

The 3 months – 24 month olds programme is designed around the developmental milestones that children need to reach at the different stages of their young lives. Focusing on doing, seeing and hearing, gross motor, communication skills and exploration we will develop and extend the children according to their individual needs.

As they grow we focus on:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development
Thinking & Memory Skills
Knowledge and Understanding of the World
Creative Development

Communication, Language & Literacy Skills
Reasoning & Numeracy
Health & Physical Development



The two year olds programme is designed to allow two-year-olds to learn through play while encouraging individual interests. By promoting independence and developing an emerging awareness of social behaviour, we help the young child expand their world beyond the home to the school community. Educators support growing independence by providing opportunities for classroom jobs: putting things away, pouring milk, washing hands, and choosing materials and activities during indoor time. Many opportunities are provided to increase a child's ability to communicate by developing active listening and expressive language skills.

Throughout the day children make self-directed but carefully guided choices, participate in small groups, take part in circle time, and build the confidence needed to try new things. Children enjoy free play to allow creativity and imagination to flourish. Educators facilitate opportunities for children to engage in reading, writing, listening, and speaking using poems, finger plays, puppets, singing, and rhyming.

The development of language, math and science is emphasised through whole-group work and encouraged during both outdoor and indoor time. As children show an interest in different subjects, practitioners partner with parents to help accomplish important milestones with pride. A consistent approach and an encouraging environment are the keys to politely outspoken and well-toned children.

Pre - School



Three -year-olds are full of wonder. This is an exciting time for these young learners, who are changing physically, cognitively, socially, and emotionally. The focus of the pre-school program is to give children the opportunity to learn through play in a loving, caring environment. Days are filled with busy explorations, investigations, and discoveries. Children express themselves through art, music and movement. They practise math and number concepts using age-appropriate materials to organise, sort, count, build and sequence. They explore the world of science through weather, cooking and seasonal activities. They develop motor skills and coordination while running, jumping, hopping, skipping, throwing, and catching in the gym. They demonstrate an emerging love of reading and writing, using growing literacy skills during story time and interactive online stories.

Children use language to share, communicate and interact with friends. They enjoy books, stories, games, projects and songs based on curricular themes that are introduced in a whole-group setting and then extended to small-group work. Our children begin to develop a rich vocabulary and use language on a daily basis through informal conversations with their practitioners and friends. They discover a new way to express themselves both in words and ideas. This allows their social world to expand even further. Days are filled with making meaning of every learning opportunity encountered at school.



The 4 to 5 year olds curriculum is designed to encourage the young child to be imaginative, energetic, inquiry-based learners who explore the classroom environment with curiosity and purpose. Preschool children are eager to learn, and school activities are designed to involve and engage these young learners with interesting lessons and materials. Experienced and qualified practitioners plan math, literacy, science, social studies, art, music and movement to thoroughly prepare children for a smooth transition to Grade R.

Children are invited to make independent choices in a child-friendly learning environment, following well-established structures and routines to guide them. Opportunities for hands-on learning are presented daily, allowing the young child to grow through play and real-world experiences. Daily activities are scheduled in whole group and small groups to promote socialisation and community building. Children engage in conversations with practitioners and friends daily, learning to take turns, listen, and share.
