



HIGH SCHOOL SPORTS OVERVIEW

Athletics & Cross-Country:

The athletics team participate in the Johannesburg Co-Ed Schools League in Term 3. The team won the 'F' League in 2015 and will be running in the 'E' League in 2016. A number of athletes compete in the Cross-Country League in Term 2.

Cricket:

The cricketers compete in the Johannesburg Schools Cricket League which takes place in Term 4 and Term 1 of the following year. The school has 1st, u15 and u14 teams. The teams were part of the 'C' league in 2015/16 after winning the 'E' League in 2014/15.

Equestrian:

The riders compete in the Gauteng West Region throughout the year. The riders compete individually as well as a team in various categories.

Golf:

The golfers participate in the Central Gauteng Schools League in Term 1 & 4 and in various tournaments throughout the year. The 'A' team won the league in 2014/15 and the 'B' team play in the 'B' League.

Hockey:

The 1st and u15 boys' teams won the Southern Gauteng Schools' 'C' league in 2015. The 1st team played in the 2015 Aitken Cup 'C' section, finishing 7th. The u15 side won the 2015 Boden Cup 'B' section which means 'A' league competition in 2016. The 1st and u15 girls' won the Southern Gauteng District 9/10 league 'D' pool in 2015 and will be part of the 'C' pool in 2016. Hockey takes place from March in Term 1 through Term 2.

Tennis:

The boys' and girls' teams compete in the Southern Gauteng Leagues in term 1 and 4. The girls' team won Pool C3 in 2015 and won all their matches in Pool C2 in term 1 2016.

Netball:

The netball teams participate in the Gauteng D10 league. The 1st and u15 sides won their 2015 league and competed in the district play-offs. Hockey takes place from March in Term 1 through Term 2.

Rugby:

The school has joined the Kudu league in 2016. This is a league for smaller rugby-playing schools. The 1st, u16 and u15 (including u14s) play from March in Term 1 through Term 2.

Soccer:

The boys' teams play in the Johannesburg School, Boys' League. In 2015 the u15 and u14 teams finished on top of their league pool while the 1st and u16s came 4th. This qualified them for the cup play-offs. The 1st, u16 and u14 sides lost in the ¼ finals while the u15s progressed to the semis. The 1st, u15A and B sides play in the JWV league made up of schools from Johannesburg and Ekurhuleni. The season takes place in Term 3

Softball:

The softball girls participated in the Diverse Sports League that takes place in Term 1 and 4. The 1st and u15 teams won the league in the 2015/16 season.

Swimming:

The swimmers competed in the Gauteng Co-Ed Schools 'D' League in 2016. The team finished 2nd. The swimming season is Term 1 and 4.

Street Dance:

The dancers compete in the newly-formed Dance Sport School League in Johannesburg. The competitions take place in Term 1 and 4.
