Music (piano, guitar, drums, violin and vocals) and dance (modern dancing, tap, ballet and hip-hop)

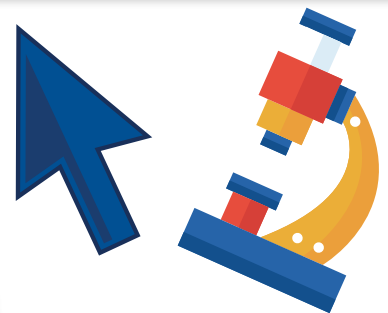

## Sports activities

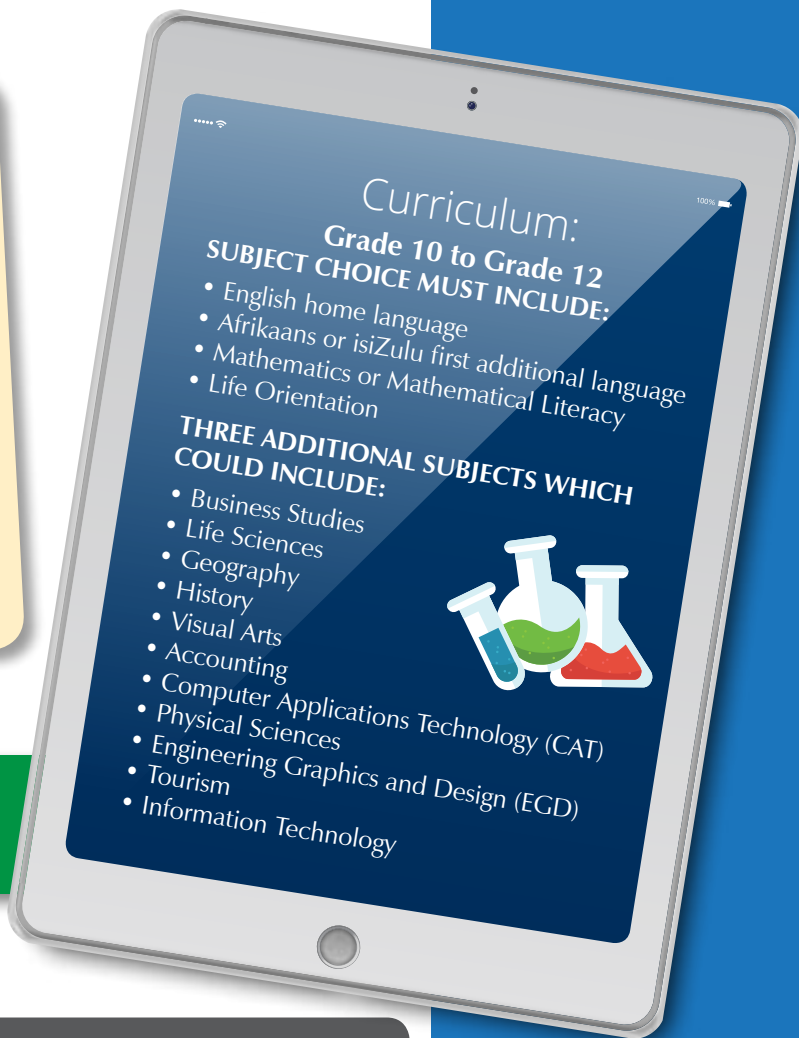
Netball, rugby, cricket, soccer (boys and girls), hockey (boys and girls), tennis, swimming, badminton, athletics, cross-country and equestrian
