

# MINIMUM CRITERIA TO QUALIFY FOR THE RUTA SECHABA SCHOLARSHIP

All applicants are required to complete an application form and submit all the required information in order to be considered eligible to receive a scholarship.

Applications open on 25 June 2018 and close at 17:00 on 3 August 2018. Please submit the completed application forms to capitecbank@curro.co.za.

#### **ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS:**

Only learners who meet the following criteria will be considered:

- 1. Black learners only (Black means African, Coloured and Indian as defined by the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 'BBBEE Act');
- 2. Black learners (as defined by the BBBEE Act) who are South African citizens only;
- 3. New learners from Grades 8 to 11;
- 4. Existing learners from Grades 8 to 12;
- 5. Learners achieving academic excellence measured as:
  - Attaining an overall aggregate of 60% or above in the latest academic report;
  - Attaining at least 60% in Mathematics and English in the latest academic report (hereinafter referred to as 'Minimum Academic Standards').
- 6. Scholarships awarded will be for the learners remaining school career, subject to them maintaining the averages on which the initial reward was calculated. In evaluating the learner's progress, the Executive Head and Regional Head will have regard for the expected decline in academic averages as the learner progresses to higher grades. If a learner fails to meet minimum standards, the learner may be obliged to attend corrective interventions, designed by the school, to support the learner. Failure to attend the corrective interventions and show progress over a period of time, may result in the scholarship being reduced or terminated accordingly. Furthermore, the Minimum Financial Need Requirement must continue to be met.

## **GENERAL**

- Capitec, the Scholarships Approval Committee and the Foundation may exercise its discretion
  in awarding scholarships where a learner will make a definite positive contribution to the
  school on various levels, but falls just short of the specific criteria on each individual level.
  Awarding the scholarship will depend on the financial circumstances of Capitec and the Ruta
  Sechaba Foundation.
- 2. Scholarships are only to be offered if there is sufficient spare capacity in the relevant grades within the participating school.
- 3. Capitec, the Foundation and the Scholarship Approval Committee reserves the right to amend, remove or change any of the terms relating to this scholarship policy, at any time and without consultation.







- 1. Applications for scholarships are considered by Capitec, the Executive Head and the Regional Head of the participating school with recommendations submitted to the Approvals Committee.
- 2. All scholarships are awarded on an annual basis and all awarded scholarships are reviewed annually.
- 3. Schools which will accept successful applicants are:

- 4. The scholarship will include all school fees, the purchase of a tablet, registration fees, connectivity fees, stationery costs as provided by the school and all academic tours organised by the school.
- 5. The scholarship will **not** cover hostel fees, uniform costs, daily transport to and from school, extramural activities, sports costs and other sundry amounts due by the parent/guardian from time to time.
- 6. Learners and parents/guardians will still be required to complete all the necessary documentation required for admission to the school, including the Learner Admission Contract.
- Scholarships are not payable in cash and will be set-off/deducted from the monthly school fees if awarded.
- 8. Scholarships may not be substituted or passed onto another learner as a gift.
- 9. In the event of the death of the Capitec employee, or in the event of him/her being permanently disabled and unable to continue working at Capitec, the scholarship will continue for the remainder of the learner's school-going years, provided that their academic results continue to meet the scholarship requirements.
- 10. If a learner decides to leave the school prior to the completion of the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded, he/she will forfeit the remainder of the scholarship not yet utilised and shall have no further claim thereon.
- 11. The benefit of the scholarship applies to the children of Capitec employees. If the parent leaves the employment of Capitec, the learner risks losing the scholarship.
- 12. The scholarship may be terminated at any point should the learner:
  - · be guilty of misconduct in terms of the school's code of conduct and other school policies; or
  - fail to maintain satisfactory progress in his/her studies as set out above; or
  - fail to observe the terms and conditions contained herein.
