

Dress Guidelines

General

- Clothing should fit well and be age-appropriate.
- Clothing with distasteful slogans, words or pictures are not allowed.
- Clothing should be neat, clean and intact.
- Excessive or distasteful piercings are not allowed.
- Shoes should always be worn.
- Nails should be kept short and clean.
- Hair should not fall over the face and should always be kept neat.
- Jeans, long pants and shorts with T-shirts and tops are suggested.
- Caps, hats, hoodies or beanies are not allowed indoors.
- Rule of thumb: when in doubt, rather don't wear it.

Girls

- Revealing and see-through tops or pants are not allowed.
- Tights are allowed only if a long shirt or dress covers the bottom.
- Shorts and skirts should reach the knee.
- Tummies must be covered and may not be exposed.
- Blouses and tops should be buttoned up properly.
- No 'spaghetti-strap' tops may be worn
- Make-up should be kept minimal.
- For younger learners we ask that shorts be worn under skirts and dresses.

Boys

- Facial hair must be shaved – no beards or moustaches.
- Saggy pants or torn jeans are not allowed.
- No sleeveless 'muscle tops/vests' may be worn.
