Congratulations to the Matric Class of 2020. They have produced outstanding results and can be very pleased with their efforts. Whilst we recognise our top achievers, I commend all our pupils as I am aware many have achieved beyond their expectations when they entered the school. We also commend the Matric Class of 2020, as they had the unique challenge of dealing with the pandemic, and they must be warmly congratulated on still producing such excellent results, despite these unusual challenges!

Achieving such fine results requires the support and expertise of staff, and I congratulate them and thank them for their guidance and support of the 2020 Matric Class, particularly under challenging circumstances.

Particular congratulations to: Megan McGaw who received 8 As; Kaitlin Howes and Tamryn Edwards who each achieved 7 As; Lleyton Marshall and Zoe Schroder who achieved 6 As. (A list of top achievers follows at the end of this newsletter).

Some statistics to reflect on, which are a brief summary of these excellent results:

- 100% pass (94.4% Bachelor's Degree Pass – BD)
- 8 As – 1 pupil
- 7 As – 2 pupils
- 6 As – 2 pupils
- 5 As – 6 pupils
- 4 As – 4 pupils
- 3 As – 7 pupils
- Average across all subjects = 71%
- 31% of all subject symbols were an A symbol
- 58% of all subject symbols were a B symbol or above
- 78% of all subject symbols were a C symbol or above
- Total number of distinctions = 159
- There were 9 subject results of 79%
- Number of distinctions per pupil = 2.2
- 13 subjects achieved averages greater than 70%
- 14 of the 18 subjects were above IEB subject averages
- 2 pupils were in the **IEB Commendable Achievements List** (achieved within top 5% in 5 subjects and achieved a rating of level 7 in LO)
- 13 pupils were in the top 1% of their subjects
