- On-site kitchen
- Designated staff have levels 1 and 2 first-aid training

- Dedicated cot or bed for each child

Daily programme

Our programme involves the following:

- Theme exploration
- Creative activities
- One-on-one creation time
- Free play
- Movement development
- Perceptual, sensory and loose-parts play

- Story and language time
- Nap and snack times

Preschool fees include

- Breakfast, lunch and a morning snack (parents to pack an afternoon snack)
- Open during school holidays (minimal additional cost from Group 2 for special activities)
- All in-class developmental activities
- Specialised programmes: Robotics, baby gym, balance bikes on dirt tracks, phonological awareness programme (Group 5)
