

What are the requirements for online learning?

- Access to a laptop, computer, or tablet with a minimum i5 processor, that runs on Windows 10, Android, or iOS operating systems.
- Device should have a camera for assessment purposes.
- Stable Internet connection such as LTE (4G).
- Dedicated, quiet learning space.
- Self-motivation and great discipline to keep up with their work.

In the intermediate phase, the emphasis is on establishing basic foundations, but learners are guided into more abstract thought and independent work. Application of skills and concepts is a focus area in this phase, while exposing learners to 21st-century technology. Furthermore, this phase aims to prepare learners for the senior phase in high school.

HOW TO ENROL

STEP 1:

STEP 2:

Please ensure that all supporting documents required are uploaded successfully, as your application cannot be processed without them.

STEP 3:

Application forms will be assessed.

STEP 4:

If successful, parents will receive via email, a welcome letter and invoice for a once-off non-refundable enrolment fee.

STEP 5:

Once the enrolment fee is paid, the child's place is confirmed (please retain proof of payment for record purposes).

STEP 6:
