GENERAL

1. School fees

School fees for 2027 exclude the following:

- All textbooks, workbooks, learning materials (including the cost of e-books) and stationery requirements – please contact the school for more information and related costs
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for non-academic school excursions and sports trips, unless otherwise advised by the school (when making payment, please use the reference number (WAT-_____) or (100_____) as per school fee statement) – please note: learners may not attend tours or outings if fees are not paid up to date
- Grade 12 IEB examination fee (invoiced separately on statement)
- The e-learning device and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device – the school will provide details and the minimum specifications for the device
- School uniforms
- Fees for therapists and psychologists

2. Savings

Savings are applicable only to the tuition portion of the fees.

- **Annual saving:** 5% granted on a 12-month advance payment.
- **Family saving:** 5% granted on the annual and monthly school fees of the younger siblings
- **Bursary:** Awarded bursaries are deducted only on the tuition fee portion and after all other savings

3. Termination of enrolment

Parents/Guardians may terminate the admission and enrolment of a learner after the commencement of the first day of the school year by providing the school with at **least 3 (three) calendar months'** written notice of termination.

4. Curro Choice: Wider subject choice offering

Learners have access to a wider subject choice (beyond what we offer at school). These may be taken instead of any elective subject, or as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject. Additional costs as outlined below are applicable only when taken as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject.

There is **no charge** for a Curro Choice subject taken as a **7th subject**.
