GENERAL

1. School fees

School fees for 2026 exclude the following:

- The e-learning device and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device itself
- All textbooks and learning materials (including the cost of e-books)
- School uniforms
- All school stationery
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for school excursions and sports trips, unless otherwise advised by the school
- School photos
- Therapists' and psychologists' fees

2. E-learning devices

E-learning devices will be utilised by all learners from Grade 8 to Grade 12.

This will have the following impact on you:

- If your child is in Grade 8 to Grade 12, you will be responsible for purchasing an e-learning device for your child to use. The school will provide you with details and the minimum specifications required for the device.
- You will be responsible for the insurance and general maintenance and care of the device.

3. Termination of enrolment

Parents/Guardians may terminate the admission and enrolment of a learner after the commencement of the first day of the school year by providing the school with at **least 3 (three) calendar months'** written notice of termination.

4. Curro Choice: Wider subject choice offering

A wider subject choice offering is available to all learners at Curro and Curro-managed schools across the country. The digital classes are available during normal class times. An additional charge is applicable to learners who opt for an additional subject (8th, 9th or 10th subjects), as outlined below.
