# CURRO<sup>PM</sup>

## Where is CurroPM?

CurroPM runs on the state-of-the-art Curro Durbanville High School campus (2 Akademia Road, Groot Phesantekraal Estate, Durbanville, Cape Town).

## What grades are taught at CurroPM?

Grades 7 to 9, with higher grades phasing in annually

## Which curriculum is used?

CurroPM learners will follow the same enhanced curriculum as Curro Durbanville High School with learners writing the IEB exams in Grade 12. Our curriculum is designed with global standards in mind and allows our learners to compete in a global market.

## What does the school day look like at CurroPM?

School times are as follows:

- 13:45 – 18:30 (Monday to Thursday)
- 13:45 – 16:00 (Friday)
- 20-minute break

The timetable runs on a 10-day cycle with six lessons on Mondays through Thursdays, and three lessons on Fridays.

## Is CurroPM right for my child?

CurroPM is the right choice for goal-driven, academic learners and learners involved in high-performance sports and culture activities.

## What does CurroPM offer my child?

CurroPM provides learners with the opportunity to:

- pursue their academic goals;
- be themselves in a relaxed, close-knit setting;
- meet like-minded people;
- enjoy Curro Durbanville's sporting facilities including the dance and drama studios, and
- engage with Curro Durbanville's therapists and counsellors.

## What subjects are offered at CurroPM?

In Grades 7 to 9, learners will have access to the following subjects:

- English Home Language
- Afrikaans First Additional Language
- Mathematics
- Life Orientation
- Coding and Robotics
- Dramatic Arts and Visual Arts
- History and Geography
- Business Studies (only in Grade 8) and Accounting (only in Grade 9)
- Life Sciences and Physical Sciences

The following subjects are available through Curro Choice:

- Sesotho First Additional Language
- isiXhosa First Additional Language

Etienne Pienaar, our Head of Academics, will be able to assist with inquiries around possible subject combinations.

## What is the sports/culture offering at CurroPM?

While extramural activities are not compulsory at CurroPM, they are available.

## What is the uniform at CurroPM?

We offer a more relaxed uniform at CurroPM. Learners must be neatly dressed in civvies that are in keeping with our dress code.

On acceptance into CurroPM, learners will receive a complimentary wolf T-shirt.

## What are the entry requirements?

Learners will be required to write benchmark tests in Mathematics and literacy before they are admitted to CurroPM.

## What are the school fees?

There is a non-refundable enrolment fee of R4 260. School fees for CurroPM are the same as the school fees for Curro Durbanville Grade 7 to Grade 9.
