This phase includes six compulsory subjects:

- At least one Home Language
- A First Additional Language
- Mathematics
- Natural Sciences and Technology
- Social Sciences
- Life Skills



Senior phase curriculum (Grade 7 to Grade 9)

This phase includes nine compulsory subjects:

- At least one Home Language
- A First Additional Language
- Mathematics
- Natural Sciences
- Social Sciences
- Life Orientation
- Creative Arts
- Economic and Management Sciences
- Technology



FET phase curriculum (Grade 10 to Grade 12)

In this phase it is compulsory to complete seven subjects, of which four are compulsory and three are elective subjects:

- English or Afrikaans Home Language
- English or Afrikaans First Additional Language
- Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy
- Life Orientation

Other subjects on offer can be discussed with the school.



HOW TO ENROL

STEP 1:

Contact the school for an interview.

STEP 2:

During the interview, documentation will be provided in order for learners to be assessed at the school. These documents should be returned to the school.

STEP 3:

Upon learner approval, registration documents will be provided for completion, which should be returned on the day that the learner starts school.

STEP 4:

Details of the learner and parent will be captured on the system and the family code to use as payment reference will be issued to the parents.

STEP 5:

The enrolment fee should be paid to confirm the learner's place before the he/she commences classes.

STEP 6:

Please refer to www.curro.co.za regularly to stay up to date with all the relevant news and arrangements.

A learner must benefit from Curro Uitzicht's mainstream curriculum and it is therefore necessary to assess each application for admission. Applicants are assessed according to the normal entry requirements and, if necessary, extra assessments may be requested.
