GENERAL

1. School fees and value-adds

School fees for 2027 include the following:

- Integrated use of innovation (Robotics, drone curriculum, 3D printing and laser cutting)
- Computer literacy (Microsoft Office, knowledge of Internet and web design, communications, and Java fundamentals)
- High school leadership programme from Grades 8 to 12
- Access to the innovation lab for projects and assignments
- Supervised after-school homework session for Grades 8 to 12
- Subject choice assessment for Grade 9 and career guidance for Grade 11
- Basic academic, behavioural and social assessments by the on-site educational psychologist
- Extra academic support for Grades 8 to 12
- Participation in national eisteddfod

School fees for 2027 exclude the following:

- The e-learning device and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device
- School uniform and blazer
- Colours and other badges for blazer
- All textbooks, workbooks, learning materials (including the cost of e-books) and stationery requirements – please contact the school for more information and related costs
- Optional leadership development camps
- International tours
- School photos
- Fees for therapists and psychologists
- Meals

2. E-learning devices

E-learning devices will be utilised by all learners from Grade 8 to Grade 12.

This will have the following impact on you:

- If your child is in Grades 8 to 12, you will be responsible for purchasing an e-learning device for your child to use. The school will provide you with details and the minimum specifications required for the device.
- You will be responsible for the insurance and general maintenance and care of the device.
- Grades 10 to 12 learners taking Computer Applications Technology (CAT) and Information Technology (IT) must purchase a device that they need to bring to school each day. Special arrangements will be made for those learners to store the devices safely during the day.

3. Termination of enrolment

Parents/Guardians may terminate the admission and enrolment of a learner after the commencement of the first day of the school year by providing the school with at **least 3 (three) calendar months'** written notice of termination.

4. Curro Choice: Wider subject choice offering

Learners have access to a wider subject choice (beyond what we offer at school). These may be taken instead of any elective subject, or as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject. Additional costs as outlined below are applicable only when taken as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject.
