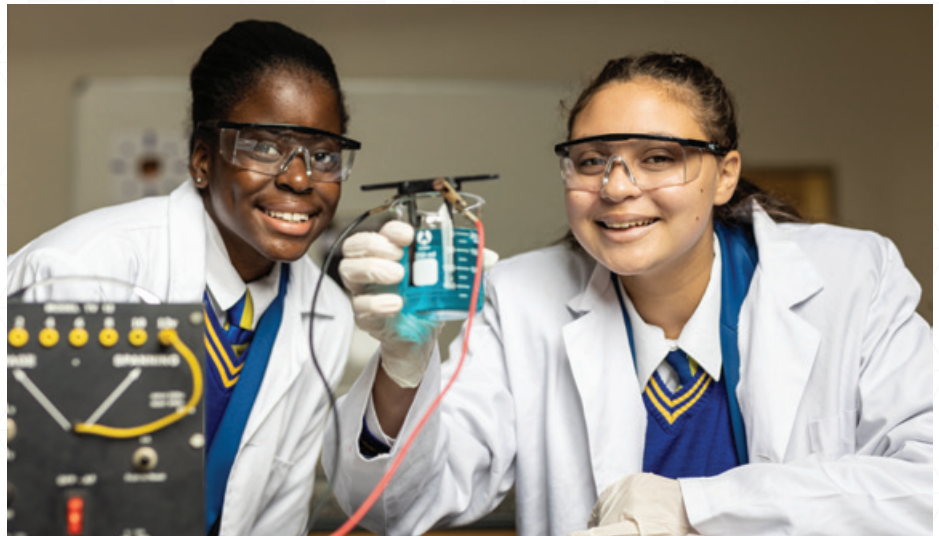

We rely on predictable monthly cash flows to manage our affairs.

## GENERAL

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### 1. School fees

School fees for 2024 exclude the following:

- Textbooks and stationery (including e-books) – certain textbooks for Grade R to Grade 7 will be invoiced on statement
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for school excursions and sports trips, unless otherwise advised by the school; when making payment, please use the reference number provided on the school letter pertaining to these costs (learners may not attend tours or outings if fees are not paid up to date)
- Grade 12 IEB examination fees (invoiced separately on statement)
- Hearing and vision screening for Group 3 to Group 5 and Grade R to Grade 3 (optional)
- The e-learning device (tablet) and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device
- School uniforms
- Therapists' and psychologists' fees

### 2. Preschool

- Full-day hours: 07:00 – 17:30
- Half-day hours: 07:00 – 14:00
- Penalty fee for late collection: R200 per half an hour or part thereof
- Preschool holiday aftercare: R300 per day
- A full calendar month's written notice is required to change from half-day to full-day or from full-day to half-day
- The preschool is not open on public holidays and will be closed from 15 December 2024

Preschool fees include:

- Healthy meals (breakfast, lunch, mid-morning, and mid-afternoon snack)
- All educational materials



Preschool fees exclude:

- Baby formula, nappies, wet wipes and baby toiletries
- Some optional activities may carry a charge

### 3. Aftercare

- The aftercare fees are invoiced to the school fee account.
- A meal and a snack are included in full-day care.
- Supervised limited-support homework classes will take place every school-day afternoon (foundation phase from 14:00 – 15:00 and intersen phase from 15:00 – 16:00).
- These classes exclude specialised subject and homework support.
- Learners provide their own stationery for homework.
- Aftercare is signed up for a term at a time, a term being three months as per the school calendar.
- Any cancellation requires a full calendar month's written notice before the end of a term.
- The holidays referred to are school holidays.
- The aftercare is not open on public holidays and closes from 11 December 2024.
- There are no additional levies, although some optional activities during the holidays may carry a charge.
- Holiday care has no charge for learners attending aftercare during the term (this excludes day visitors).
- Penalty fee for late collection (aftercare closes at 17:30): A R200 penalty fee per half an hour or part thereof for first-time offenders and R200 per 15 minutes or part thereof for repeat offenders.

### 4. E-learning devices (tablets)

E-learning devices (tablets) will be utilised by all learners from Grade 4 to Grade 12.

This will have the following impact on you:

- If your child is in Grade 4 to Grade 12, you will be responsible for purchasing an e-learning device (tablet) for your child to use. The school will provide you with details and the minimum specifications required for the device.
- You will be responsible for the insurance and general maintenance and care of the device.

### 5. Savings

Savings are applicable only to the tuition portion of the fees.

- **Annual saving:** 5% granted on a 12-month advance payment, which is strictly due by 31 January 2024.
- **Family saving:** A 5% saving will be granted on the annual and monthly school fees of the younger siblings.
- **Bursary:** Awarded bursaries are deducted only on the tuition fee portion and after all other savings.



## 6. Notice periods

- For notice to leave the school, **three full calendar months' notice is required.**
- A full calendar month's written notice is required for any changes to or cancellation of services. This includes sports programmes and changes from full-day to half-day and vice versa at the preschool.
- If the full three calendar months' notice is not received, fees for the full three months will still be payable.

## 7. Curro Choice: Wider subject choice offering

A wider subject choice offering is now available to all learners at Curro and Curro-managed schools across the country. The digital classes are available during normal class times. An additional charge is applicable to learners who opt for an additional subject (8th, 9th or 10th subjects), as outlined below.
